The institute celebrated the 71st Republic Day by hoisting the national flag followed by a speech by the Principal.



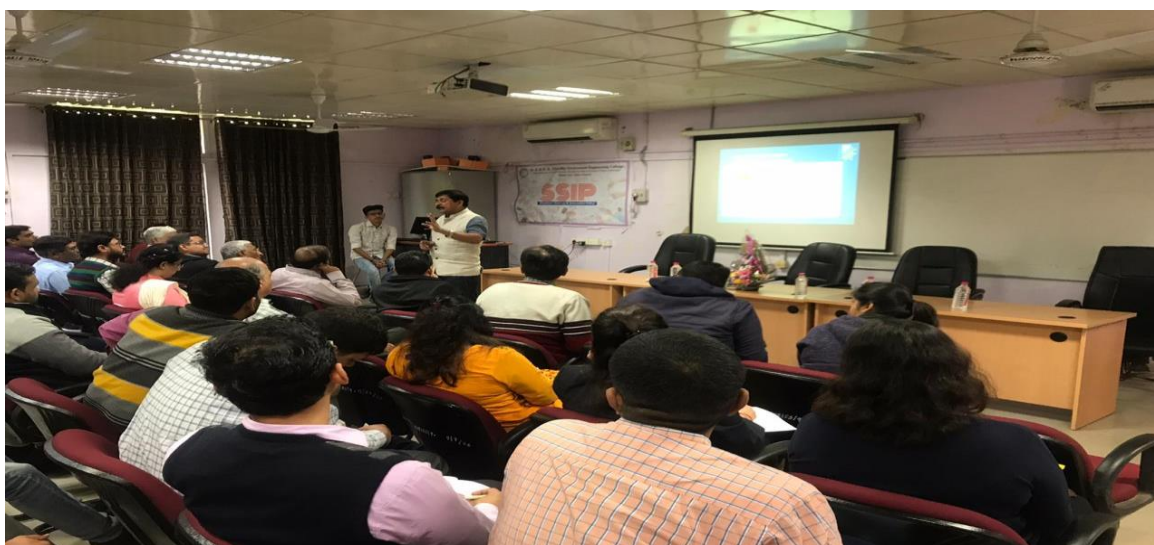
Off Campus Drive
