YOGA DAY CELEBRATION

Government Polytechnic, Valsad celebrated the 8th International Yoga Day with zealous fervor on 21st June 2022. Yoga, an age old practice for a healthier body and a peaceful mind, is celebrated internationally on 21st June every year. The heritage of our ancestors is resplendently cherished and awareness is spread regarding the blessings of Yoga. The day is commemorated all over the world by performing pranayama and yogasanas.

The function at the institute began early in the morning at 6 a.m. with the viewing of the telecast of the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi led the Yoga Day celebrations from the Mysuru Palace Ground, Karnataka at the Civil Seminar Hall.



The Principal, Shri C. H. Bhatt, continued the ceremony with a speech on the physical benefits of Yoga and its role in stress management. Yoga was termed crucial for students to improve concentration, enhance memory and boost motivation. It was against this background that the yoga session planned for all commenced.



Shri Kiran Patel, Lecturer, Plastic Engineering Department and a yoga enthusiast conducted the session for the faculty members, staff members and students. He began with the chant of Om and Gayatri mantra which charged the atmosphere with a positive energy. The participants were then guided through light aasanas followed by more complex ones.
